As we prepare for the close of this academic year, kindly be reminded of the following significant events which we have shared with you earlier on.

Update on School Events

1. Off Day In Lieu of Hari Raya Puasa (15 October 2007)

This is a gentle reminder that **Monday, 15 October** is a school holiday in-lieu for Hari Raya Puasa, a public holiday which falls on Saturday, 13 October 2007.

2. PSLE Marking Exercise (16 – 19 October 2007)

This is a gentle reminder that there will be no school for P1-P6 pupils from **16 to 19 October** as teachers will be involved in this exercise.

3. P3 Selection Test for the Gifted Education Programme (17 – 18 October 2007)

If your son/ward has been short-listed for the P3 Selection Test, he would have been given a letter of notification on **2 October** by his Class Teacher to sit for the test. The P3 Selection Test will be held on **17 and 18 October**. Kindly note: the school will be providing transport to and from Kheng Cheng School. I am pleased to announce that 79 of our P3 pupils were identified to take the P3 Selection Test. It is heartening to note that the successful candidates come from all the P3 classes. This will surely go a long way to motivate and encourage all the pupils.
