Dear Parents/Guardian,

The first week of school got onto a smooth start. Thank God for the many parent volunteers who were on hand to assist our P1 teachers manage the new P1 pupils. I would like to take this opportunity to highlight a few matters:

1. Student Activity Area at Chancery Lane

LTA has given the school a Temporary Occupation Licence (TOL) to use the area at the Chancery Lane as a Student Activity Area. The school has strictly been informed by LTA that it should **not** be used as a carpark.

The Student Activity Area at Chancery Lane is used by our students for various outdoor activities. The school has designated it a pick-up and drop-off point to ease the traffic situation at Dunearn Road only during peak hours. Please be reminded that this is not a carpark. Thus, we request all parents to use the area for pick up and drop off purposes only. Otherwise, the TOL may not be renewed by LTA.

The opening hours of the Student Activity Area at Chancery Lane for pick up and drop off purposes are as follows from Mondays to Fridays:

Morning : 6.30 – 8.00am
Afternoon : 12.00 – 2.15pm

We have installed a metal barrier at the Student Activity Area to ensure that the Student Activity Area is made available to our students for their outdoor activities at all times. The security guards will not entertain any requests to open the Student Activity Area to anyone who parks his vehicle beyond the opening hours.

We request your understanding in this matter as the Student Activity Area is specially for the use of pupils and seek your cooperation to adhere closely to the opening hours of this designated pick up and drop off point.

2. Access to the Campus via Gate C

Parents/Guardian can also access into the Campus via Gate C, which is located between the Administration Block and ACS (BR). This gate will be opened on weekdays from 6.30 to 7.45am and 1.15 to 2.00pm and it will be manned by a security officer. Parents/Guardian are encouraged to use this gate for pick up and drop off their son/ward so as to ease the traffic at the Transport Centre.

3. Vigilance against Avian Flu and Other Infectious Diseases

Parents/Guardian are reminded that if your son/ward is unwell, please bring him to see a doctor and do not send him to school until certified fit to do so by the doctor. This will help the child to recuperate quickly and also ensure that other pupils are not affected as well.

4. YMCA After-School Care Service

YMCA is offering after-school care service to all ACS(P) pupils. Monthly fees of \$350.00 will cover lunch, bath and tea-break. Programme includes supervised study, activity and nap-time.
