Dear Parents/Guardian,

As the term draws to a close, I would like to take this opportunity to share with you a few items for your immediate attention:

1. Exemption from Mother Tongue

Please be informed that pupils who are exempted from taking the Mother Tongue examination need not be in school on Wednesday, 31 October 2007. Pupils who are exempted but would like to sit for the paper can do so after the end of the examinations.

2. End-of-Year (EOY) Examinations School Hours

Please be reminded that the school hours for all pupils from **29 October to 1 November will be from 7.30 to 10.30am**. For pupils who are using the school bus service, arrangements have been made for the school bus transport to ferry the pupils home at 10.30am.

3. Students going on holiday

The last day of the academic school year is on Friday, 16 November 2007. You are reminded that the school will not give permission for any student to leave the school earlier for holiday purpose. Please send the right message to your children.

4. Indiscriminate parking outside the school / Leaving car engines on inside Transport Centre

We have a number of parents/guardians who continue to park their cars outside the school gate or bus bay in such a way that they obstruct the flow of traffic. Such indiscriminate parking is also a danger to other drivers as well as pedestrians.

Please also avoid leaving your car engine on when you are in the Transport Centre as dangerous fumes are being emitted and this will be harmful to all who are present.

Being considerate is basic social behaviour and we are expected to be courteous to all. We should also set good examples to all our children. If we are inconsiderate, they learn to be inconsiderate too.

5. Occupying seats in the school canteen

While parents/guardians and other care-givers are welcome to use the canteen, please be reminded that you should give up your seats during recess and after school so that our pupils will be able to find a seat to have their meal. The school has resorted to placing 'Reserved for Students' signs on selected tables as parents/guardians and other caregivers have ignored previous reminders. Even with this in place, some have continued to occupy the seats while our pupils have to stand and have their lunch. Some even told the pupils that if others are doing it, why can't they when they are approached by our pupils. It is regrettable that we adults are not setting good examples for the young ones.
