The ACS (Primary) Bursary Fund *In Loving Memory of Tan Khung Ngee* was established in April 2010. The late Mr Tan Khung Ngee was a businessman who believed firmly in the value of a good education and his three sons had the benefit of an ACS education. He shared a similar belief with one of modern history's greatest economist, Nobel Laureate, and a champion of education reform, the late Dr Milton Friedman, that

*"A stable and democratic society is impossible without widespread acceptance of some common set of values and without a minimum degree of literacy and knowledge on the part of most citizens. Education contributes to both. In consequence, the gain from the education of a child accrues not only to the child or to his parents but to other members of the society." - Milton Friedman, 1955*

The Greek philosopher Plato mused that, *"The direction in which education starts a man will determine his future"* - Plato, *The Republics*. So too did the late Mr Tan believe in this.

The bursaries will be based on students' needs (not academic performance) and a committee has been set up to decide on the recipients.

### **Conditions for application**

1. You must be a current student in ACS (Primary) during the year of award.
2. The award is to be based on your financial needs.
3. The bursary amount is to be spent on school miscellaneous items or other related school items such as textbooks and CCA programmes. It is not meant to be used for overseas educational trips. The bursary may also be used for transport to and from school, and recess pocket money.

### **The Bursary**

1. A one-time cash award of S\$1000 each per year per bursary shall be given out.
2. A maximum of 5 bursaries shall be given out each year. Any bursaries not given out in a particular year due to lack of suitable candidates may be added to the number of bursaries to be given out in the following or subsequent years at the discretion of the Selection Committee.
3. The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final.

### **Procedure for application**

The Bursary will be administered by the ACS(P) School Leaders.

Please submit your application together with the relevant supporting documents as requested in the attached application form to the attention of the Principal, by the end of April each year.

Members of the Selection Panel will comprise the Principal and/or Vice-Principal and members of the School Executive Committee as appointed by the Principal.

The Bursary will be made available by May of that relevant year, and you will be informed through the school if successful.
