CHINA IMMERSION PROGRAMME (8 Days Nanjing Xing Zhi Primary School) 30 May 2010 to 6 June 2010



As part of our Chinese Enrichment programme, I am pleased to announce that school is organizing an **8-day China Cultural Immersion Tour to Nanjing** for our pupils during the coming school holidays. The objective of this study-cum-cultural immersion tour is to enable our pupils to have a better understanding of the Chinese culture and to promote a greater interest in the learning of the Chinese Language through an exposure to the Chinese culture beyond the classroom.



Chinese culture, with its long history, is rich and widespread throughout many parts of the world. Coupled with its successful economic policy, China is fast becoming an international economic and cultural force. As Singapore has close ties with China in many areas, it is essential for our students to have a better command of the Chinese Language and a greater appreciation of the Chinese culture.



Our pupils will be attending lessons with the local students in the renowned **Nanjing Xing Zhi Primary School** for 6 days. They will be immersed in an environment conducive to the learning of the language and it will also enable them to experience student life in China, thus providing opportunities for them to be self-reliant, independent and adaptable.



The 8-day programme includes school visits, cultural enrichment activities and educational tours of Nanjing. The cost for each participant is **\$1375/pax**. The cost includes airfare, all meals, accommodation, course fee, admission tickets to various places of attraction and QBE Insurance. Attached is the itinerary and booking conditions.

Kindly note that vacancies (max. 50 pupils) are limited and pupils will be selected on an interview basis. As a form of encouragement, the school will be subsidizing \$100 for all pupils* who register for this Immersion Programme.

**The subsidy is only for Singapore Citizens as the fund is taken from the MOE's Internationalisation Fund.*



The school is giving a further subsidy of \$100 to 15 pupils who show the most progress in their performance (the boys will be informed personally).
