End-Of-Year (EOY) Examinations

Please note that there is early dismissal at **10.30am** for P1-P6 pupils on **Friday, 29 October to Tuesday, 2 November**. Kindly note that during these three days, there will be no recess in the midst of the examination and pupils can only have food after dismissal at 10.30am. **Please ensure that your son/ward has his breakfast at home/ before school starts.**



For pupils who are taking the school bus service, the school bus transport will pick up the pupils at 10.30am.

Pupils who are exempted from taking Mother Tongue at PSLE, are not required to attend school on Monday, 1 November.
