## 2010 P5 Adventure Camp @ MOE Dairy Farm Adventure Centre



Barring any unforeseen circumstances/i.e. if everything proceeds as planned; The P5 boys will be attending a 3-day residential camp from 19 July 2010 (Monday) to 21 July 2010 (Wednesday) at the MOE Dairy Farm Adventure Centre.



On the first day (19 July 2010), the boys will be reporting to school at the usual assembly time and will be taken to the venue by bus. They will be back in school on the last day (21 July 2010) by 1.00 pm and will be dismissed at the transport centre. School buses will be available to ferry the boys back home. Please be informed that the boys will not be dismissed from the campsite. We seek your kind understanding on this matter.



The camp will incorporate adventure learning and character development. It seeks to explore and impart values of teamwork, cooperation and confidence-building through various challenges that will require them to explore beyond their comfort zones in finding solutions for complex situations.



Every activity, including the high rope obstacles course, focuses on group facilitation to ensure that learning points are delivered and internalised. The camp organizers and facilitators, Inno Trek Pte Ltd, are professionals in their field and have extensive experience in running such camps and training programmes. Teacher will also be at the camp throughout the three days to help the boys adapt to the environment.



All camp participants are required to wear track-pants for the activities, especially when executing the challenge-rope courses. Pupils may wear their own navy blue/black track pants; or purchase the ACS track-pants (navy blue) at \$19 each on the 6th and 7th July 2010 from 9 am to 2 pm at the school canteen.



The cost of the camp is partially subsidized by the school; the remaining balance was factored into the miscellaneous fee which was collected at the beginning of the year. Attached behind this letter is a packing list for the camp.
